

MINUTES OF 2nd MEETING OF SCREENING COMMITTEE FOR THE YEAR 2019-20 HELD ON 18.09.2019 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF HON'BLE I&PH MINISTER FOR PROCUREMENT PIPES & G.I. WIRE TO BE USED IN I&PH DEPARTMENT.

At the outset, the Member Secretary welcomed the Hon'ble IPH Minister & other members of the committee.

Thereafter, discussion on agenda items followed as under:

ITEM No. I Procurement of G.I. Pipes:

The Member Secretary explained in the meeting that as per decision taken in the 1st meeting of Screening Committee fresh online tender for procurement of G.I. Pipes for annual requirement were called and same were opened on 14.08.2019. The negotiated rates recommended by negotiation committee constituted vide Principal Secretary (I&PH) notification no. PBW(PH)5(2)1-84-X dated 27.11.2008 headed by Engineer-in-Chief were considered and approved as per Annexure "A". for procurement of G.I. Pipes valid up to 30.06.2020.

In this regard the Hon'ble chairman showed his concern about that since new project under Jal Jeevan Mission which is be executed in a time bound manner and pipes required under Jal Jeevan Mission should be included in this tender hence it was decided that the same also be procured against this tender after approval of screening committee. However for the project costing more than Rs. 15 Crore (under JJM) complete tender be called including providing, laying & fixing of Pipes on through rates and for other works costing less than Rs. 15 Crore, the requirement be got from Chief Engineers of Zones and put up for consideration and approval of Screening committee.

Member secretary explained that in the 1st meeting of screening committee annual requirement of 16340 MT was approved but now some additional requirement for ongoing works has been received from IPH Division Rohru (355 MT) & newly created division Jaswan Pragpur (681 MT). After detail discussion committee considered & approved the total Qty. of 17376 MT for its procurement against this tender (valid up to 30.06.2020).

It was also pointed out by the member secretary that to ensure the proper quality of pipes some corrective measures have also been proposed to be included in the terms

and conditions of supply orders and as well as in the next tender, which are as under:

1. Post Inspection of pipes/ material shall be got done by the consignee & 5% payment which is released only after receipt of GR shall now be released after receipt of post delivery inspection reports from consignees confirming the quality of pipes, in a time bound manner i.e. within 45 days from the receipt of material

2. New inspection agencies such as LLOYDS & BSI be also included for 100% as well as

30 % inspection.

3. A team of Engineers of I&PH will visit factory premises of the firm for verification of stock, source of procurement of raw material and proof of lifting of raw material from approved vendors in support of supplies to be made to the department.

4. The firms shall provide monthly SAIL's rate of HR Coil & rate of Zinc of Vedanta

(Hindustan Zinc Limited) to the department.

In condition no. 3 it was suggested by the Hon'ble Chairman that team

should comprise of competent engineers Headed by Superintending Engineer.

It was discussed that Civil Supplies Corporation should depute Sr. level officer not below the rank of Assistant Area Manager (AAM) for third party inspection. The Managing Director, H.P. State Civil Supplies Corporation assured that Assistant Area Manager level functionaries will be duly sent for this purpose.

Accordingly after detailed deliberations and discussions, the committee

approved the conditions for inclusion in the supply orders as well as in next tenders.

Further regarding placing of supply order to L-1, L-2, L-3, L-4 & L-5 firms, the detailed discussion was done and it is decided that to increase the competition in future the restriction of placing maximum quantity of 3000 MT may be reviewed and the supply orders may be placed in view the manufacturing capacity of the firm and after seeking the undertaking from the firms that the pipes shall be supplied within delivery period without seeking further extension.

ITEM NO.II Procurement of HDPE Pipes:-

Member Secretary explained that in addition to the annual requirement of HDPE Pipes approved in the previous Screening Committee meeting now some additional requirement of 208203 Rmt. has been received for tribal areas & ongoing PMKSY / HIMCAD projects.

After detailed deliberations & discussions, the committee approved the requirement of HDPE Pipes i.e. 208203 Rmt. and further decided to procure the same on

HPCOS rate contract valid up to 31.03.2020.

ITEM NO.III Procurement of G.I. Wire:-

Member Secretary explained that though in the previous meeting it was decided to procure G.I. Wire either on HPCOS Rate Contract or on turnkey basis by calling tenders. But the rate contract has still not been finalized & due to less requirement, procurement of GI wire on turnkey basis is also difficult.

Regarding fresh/new rate contract of G.I. Wire, the representative of Industry department mentioned that the proposal for calling tender has been sent to Govt. for

approval.

After detailed discussion committee decided that meanwhile G.I. wire be procured on previous rate contract rates after obtaining an undertaking from the firm that if there is any increase in the fresh rate contract rates the same shall not be claimed by the firm however in case of decrease the same shall be recovered and to ensure the same 5% payment of the firm shall be withheld till the finalization of fresh rate contract.

The committee considered the requirement submitted as per agenda i.e. 273 MT and found that urgent requirement of Dharmpur & Thunag Division has not been included in this & asked to consider the urgent requirement of above divisions & after considering the same, the total requirement works out 493 MT which is after including 150 MT for Dharmpur Division & 70 MT for Thunag Division. The committee approved the same as

I ITEM NO.IV Ex-Post Facto approval for procurement of HDPE Pipes.

The committee granted the ex-post facto sanction of urgent requirement of 45700 Rmt. HDPE pipes which was procured for Chopal & Jubbal area of District Shimla to restore the water Supply Schemes which were damaged severely due to excessive rains w.e.f. 16.08.2019 to18.08.2019

ADDITIONAL ITEM:

It is generally seen that that rate contact of material which is exclusively required by IPH Department and not being finalized in time bound manner and department face hardship/ difficulty in the procurement of material.

After detailed discussion it was decided that rates of G.I. Fittings & G.I. Wire may be finalized as per enology of G.I. Pipes hence Engineer-in-Chief (I&PH) authorized to call the tender at his level and bring the case for approval of Screening committee for procurement of the same.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the chair.
