NOTIFICATION

The issue of formulation of comprehensive tendering procedure for Flood Management Works has been under consideration of the Government for the past sometime. The task was assigned to State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) of Jal Shakti Department. The Committee has submitted its recommendations dated 23.04.2021 vide E-in-C office Letter No. JSV-SE(P&I)-D-I-Tech.-Committee-2020-21-517-27 dated 19.05.2021 and Letter No.ENC(JSV)P&I-I-Tech. Committee/2021-765 dated 02.06.2021.

Consequent upon the examination of the recommendations of SLTC at the Government level, the following Pre-qualification Criteria, Definition of Similar Works and Split-up Criteria are hereby ordered for all the Flood Management Works being executed under State or Central funds by any agency of Jal Shakti Department, in continuation of the Office Memorandum issued vide No.IPH-B(F) 7-6/2016 dated 10.01.2020, Addendum dated 28.07.2020 and Office Memorandum dated 09.10.2020 as under:--

1. Pre- Qualification Criteria:

- i) Average annual financial turnover during last 3 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.
- ii) Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending previous day of the last date of submission of bids should be either of the following:-
 - Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.
 - Or
 - Two Similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.

Or

One similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

The following note be incorporated in the bid documents:

- a) In case of integrated works, the value of only the similar components of the works executed as per the similar work defined shall be considered for eligibility.
- b) The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum calculated from the date of completion to previous day of last day of submission of bids.
- c) Completed work means completion of a minimum of 90% of the awarded amount of the work.
- d) The certificate in this regard be obtained on the format as prescribed in the Notice Inviting Tender.

2. Definition of "Similar Works"

Flood Management Works involving construction of one of the following components in any project for managing water of rivers, streams and flood plains for protection of all types of land and property:-

- a) Wire-crate Embankment /Spur/Aprons.
- b) Cement Concrete Embankment /Dam.

Following note be incorporated in the bid documents:-

- a) The wire thickness used for Wire crated Embankment /Spur/Aprons may be of any thickness.
- b) Concrete used in Cement Concrete Embankment /Dam may be of any design mix.

3. Split-up criteria for Flood Management Works:

The split-up of Flood Management Works be done as per the CPWD Manual Clause 3.1.1.8 keeping in view of following:-



- (a) Continuity of the works from upstream to downstream, however, priority be given to vulnerable reaches with both ends tied at higher elevation than the HFL.
- b) Stream wise provision.
- c) In the exigencies of work, the Competent Authority for according technical sanction may with reasons recorded in writing accord split-up sanction within his/her competence.

The above Terms & Conditions shall be applicable to all Flood Management Works henceforth including on recalled/cancelled tenders.

The above instructions shall be scrupulously adhered to in tendering process of all Flood Management Works by all officers of Jal Shakti Vibhag.

All other guidelines/Terms & Conditions as mentioned in Office Memorandum dated 10.01.2020 as referred to in Para 1 of this notification shall mutatis mutandis be applicable in case of Flood Management Works also.
