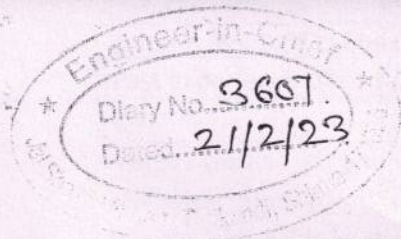



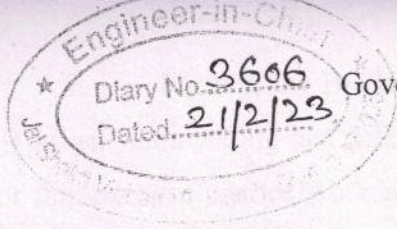

Notification

In continuation of this Department's notification No.IPH-B(A)9-1/2010-II-loose, dated 22-11-2021 and consequent upon the recommendations of 6th State Level Technical Committee for the year 2022-23 as emanating from the CVC guidelines and as per the CPWD Works Manual 2022, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to modify the eligibility and qualification criteria and add heading(D) in tendering process of Jal Shakti Vibhag as under:-

Eligibility & Qualification Criteria:

(A) For works equal to or above INR 5.00 crore:

Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following :-

- (a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost
- Or
- (b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost
- Or
- (c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost

Besides above the bidders should possess the bidding capacity calculated by the specific formula as under:

$$\text{Available Bid Capacity} = \{[A \times N \times M] - B\}$$

where "A" = Maximum value of Engineering (Civil/ Electrical/ mechanical as relevant to the work being procured) works executed in any one year during the last 5 years (updated at the current price level), taking into the account the completed as well as works in progress.

"M" = Multiplier factor is 1.5

"N" = Number of years prescribed for completion of work in Question.

"B" = Value (updated at current price level) of the existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed in next "N" years.

Further, the Bidder should have satisfactorily completed similar works during the last seven years ending last date of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited. For this purpose cost of work shall mean gross value of the completed work including cost of material supplied by the Government/Client but excluding those supplied free of cost. This should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer as per CPWD Works Manual 2022 Appendix to SOPs (No. 4/9) – Annexure 24.

(iii) Definition of “similar work” should be clearly defined in the tender document.

In addition to above, the criteria regarding satisfactory performance of works, personnel establishment, plant, equipment may be incorporated according to the requirement of project.

D) Preparation of Justification:

- (i) In case of Single Bid system, justification is prepared before opening of Financial Bid by considering market rates of material and labour as prevailing on the last date of submission of tenders.
 - (ii) In case of Two/Three Bid system, the justification is prepared before opening of Technical bid by considering market rates of material and labour as prevailing on the last date of submission of tenders. In case revised financial bids are called, fresh justification, if required, is prepared before opening the revised Financial bids.
